

Privacy Policy*

Sonshine Baptist Church (the Church) values and respects the privacy of our members and the wider community. As such, the Church has determined to create and adhere to this Privacy Policy (Policy) voluntarily.

The following describes how we collect, use, disclose and secure personal information.

In this Policy, any references to “personal information” mean any information or opinion, whether true or not, and whether recorded in a material form or not, about an identified individual or an individual who is reasonably identifiable.

Collection of Information

From time to time, the Church may collect personal information about you to advance the causes and maintain the regular administration of the Church.

Use of Information

Personal information will only ever be used for the purposes for which it was collected. The Church will not use or disclose your personal information for any other purpose without first seeking your consent, unless required by law.

Access to Information

Any request for access to the personal information we hold about you or your dependants can be made in writing to the Pastor of the Church. The Pastor, however, reserves the right to decline the request on any grounds upon consideration.

Any amendments required to personal information we hold about you or your dependants can be made in writing to the Pastor of the Church, who will then take the necessary steps (if required) to update the personal information.

Security of Information

The Church will take reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information we hold about you is kept confidential and secure.

Changes to Policy

The Church may amend this Policy from time to time in accordance with the Church’s by-laws.
